If you are applying for a food booth, please also download/fill out the Stanislaus County Health Department Temporary Food Permit Application from our website. This additional application must be filled out and approved by the county prior to the event. All printed applications must be returned to us by **August 25th, 2022** to reserve your booth. **FOOD BOOTH APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY AUGUST 18TH. ANYTHING LATER WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Please enclose with your application, the booth rental fee as well as the health permit if you are a food vendor. Make checks payable to Denair Farm & Family Association (or DFFA). You can visit our website (denairfestival.com) if you wish to fill out your application and pay with a credit card. Please make sure to send all signed material and fees to:

Please read all rules and conditions prior to returning the signed forms and fees. 5-7 Days prior to the event you will receive your registration packet via Email. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR EMAIL IS LISTED AND LEDGABLE. It will contain a map and information about your space assignment and parking. You are welcome to come setup anytime after 6am the day of the event. No need to check in at the event. Set-up time will be from 6AM to 8:30AM - Please No Early Birds.

All basic booth spaces are 12' D x 12' W. NO ELECTRICAL POWER will be supplied; you must supply your own power/generators. All generators must be quiet generators. All Food Vendor / Food Truck menus must be approved by Denair Farm & Family Association.

NOTE: We only provide the space. It is your responsibility to provide your own table, chairs, awning, or anything you might need for the booth space. The Denair Farm & Family Association shall not be held responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.

Accepted methods of payment: Cashiers Check, Check, or Visa/MC/Amex. You may also pay cash by dropping off to us at Grandma's Treasures, 4616 Main St., Denair. Please make checks payment to the Denair Farm & Family Association (or DFFA). Mail to: DFFA, PO Box 77, Denair, CA 95316. Application, payment, and health permit (if applicable) must be received by DFFA no later than **the date on the cover letter** to reserve your space.

All booths are assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis with prior year vendors having first right of refusal. Placement is at the discretion of DFFA. If your application and payment are not received by the due date a spot can not be guaranteed.

RULES OF VENDOR BOOTHS

NOTE: All food booths must be set up by 8:30am. Anyone arriving after that time will not be admitted to the festival area.

- Area around space must be left clean and free of all paper and trash. If your space is left with trash after the show we will bill you for clean up accordingly.**
- Liability insurance is the responsibility of the vendor. DFFA shall not be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged merchandise.
- No cars or trucks will be allowed on Main Street after booths are set up.
- Please enter and exit the booth area with your vehicle via the directions on the map you receive.
- Sale hours will be Saturday 9am to 3pm. You may begin setting your booth up for business after 6am Saturday morning. We require all vendors to be set up and ready for business by **8:30am**. In addition all vendors are required to stop selling and close their booths no later than 3pm.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed inside booths at any time by vendors. All vendors must conduct themselves in a professional manner. If vendor fails to comply they may be asked to close and risk further participation in DFFA events.
- If you decide to close early you WILL NOT be able to bring in any vehicle until after official close times.
- The Denair Farm & Family Association is not responsible for damages, loses or inclement weather. Stanislaus County Sheriff Officers and/or CHP will be on duty in the downtown area during the event. However we encourage you not to leave valuable equipment, supplies, or merchandise in your booth unattended.
- There will be no refunds for rain or other act, either man made or natural or if the space reservation is canceled after the deadline date.
- A complete application and all fees must be received no later than the deadline date outlined in the cover letter. Applications are considered complete and will be assigned when all permits, payments, and necessary documents are received. **Vendors may not set up until all of the above conditions are met.**
- All decisions made by the Denair Farm & Family Association and its staff are final. Vendors must comply with all laws and regulations.
- If you are a food vendor you are responsible for your own beverage supply. We no longer have a beverage sponsor.**
- The sale of any food, soft drinks or water will not be permitted by any vendor, other than those approved.**
- No Free Water is to be given out unless previously approved by the DFFA.**
- Anyone dispensing paper products or the disposal of liquid by-products must be responsible for litter containers.
- Any food items not listed on the original application will not be approved for sale by DFFA.**
- If applicable, each food vendor will be required by the Stanislaus County Health Department to fill out and return all appropriate reports and permits. In your packet you will find a copy of an application for temporary food permit. Please return to DFFA with your application prior to the deadline.
- All food vendors are expected to be ready for inspection by Stanislaus County Health Department on Saturday by 8:30am. Vendors not ready for inspection at this time run the risk of not being approved for participation in the Farm & Family Festival.
- Vendors with wheeled booths (trailers) must arrive prior to 7am on Saturday.
- The DFFA is no longer providing ice to vendors. Ice is available to purchase at the liquor store on Main and San Joaquin as well as the stores on Main Street on the other side of the rail road tracks. Please plan accordingly for your ice usage.
